

- Respect lives and physical and mental integrity of those not or no longer fighting
- Guarantee basic needs (food, shelter, medical services) of those who are not or no longer fighting
- Allow humanitarian relief to reach those in need










PROTECTION CF ASSISTANCE

ICRC's mission is to protect the lives and dignity of victims of armed conflict and other situations of violence and to provide them with assistance.


